

Logistics – Supply

All CAP-owned equipment being assigned to a member on a temporary basis will be documented on a CAPF37E. This includes, but is not limited to, the assignment of ISR radios during a bivouac, event or FTX; assignment of a practice beacon or directional finder (DF) during a training exercise; and the loaning of unit flags and color guard equipment to cadets for the purpose of training.

Members must be made aware of the responsibility of taking temporary possession of CAP-owned equipment and must sign the CAPF37E noting acceptance of this responsibility. The unit commander, or his/her designee, will hold the CAPF37E until the equipment is returned, inspected and found to be in as-issued condition.

In times of emergency, or when executing an actual mission where a CAPF37E is not readily available, this policy may be waived at the discretion of those in command
